Club Constitution

1. Name

- 1.1. South Cave & Brantingham Cricket Club

2. Policy of the Club

- 2.1. To develop a club spirit and atmosphere within which individual members are expected to consider the interest of the club over and above personal considerations.
- 2.2. To encourage young players, through promotion of ECB recommendations which relate to the development of cricket, as applicable.

3. Officers of the Club

- 3.1. The interests of the club are to be looked after by the officers voted into office by members attending a General Meeting. The Officers will collectively be known as the Committee.

- 3.2. The Committee will comprise the following members:

a) President	f) 1 st XI Captain
b) Chairperson	g) 1 st XI Vice-Captain
c) Vice-Chairperson	h) 2 nd XI Captain
d) Treasurer	i) 2 nd XI Vice-Captain
e) Secretary	j) Groundsman
f) Social Secretary	k) Junior Officer

4. Meetings

- 4.1. Meetings will take place as follows:

Annual General Meeting	October

- 4.2. Emergency General Meetings can be called by the committee as and when required.

5. Funding

- 5.1. A bank Account shall be maintained in the name of South Cave & Brantingham Cricket Club, to manage funds.
- 5.2. The signatories of the bank account shall be any minimum 2 out of 3 members authorised to do so by the club.
- 5.3. The Treasurer shall keep a full record of transactions and shall provide a report of these at each AGM.

6. New Members

6.1. All new members wishing to join the club have to be accepted by at least three members of the committee.

7. Annual Membership Fees and Match Subscriptions

7.1. Annual Membership fees to be paid by 1st June each year, lasting until the 31st May of the following year.

7.2. Non payment of fees will mean selection for a team will be prevented. If fees are not paid by the 1st June, the captains will be informed that the member concerned is not available for selection. A letter will be forwarded by the Treasurer informing the member that their fees have not been paid and that they are not eligible for selection until the matter is resolved. If no response is received within 2 months of this letter the member will be informed that they are suspended as a member of the club and will be reported to the relevant league. Non-playing members will be suspended from voting at the AGM.

7.3. Match Subscriptions shall be paid before the start of a match.

7.4. Persistent non-payers of Match Subscriptions will be dealt with under section 7.2.

7.5. Annual Membership Fees and Match Subscriptions will be reviewed annually at the AGM.

8. Selection

8.1. The 1st and 2nd Teams will be selected by a Selection Committee comprising of the following: 1st XI Captain, 2nd XI Captain and one other member of the club.

8.2. The Selection Policy will be determined by the Selection Committee. This is to suit the requirements of the Selection Committee each year.

8.3. All members will make themselves available to play for all Teams, no exceptions. Members cannot choose which team they will play for and must play for whichever team they are selected. Unless otherwise agreed by the Selection Committee.

9. Presentation of Trophies

9.1. Trophies will be awarded each year for the following, at a suitable function, arranged by the Social Secretary:

1 st XI Batting Award	1 st XI Bowling Award
2 nd Batting Award	2 nd XI Bowling Award
Clubman of the Year	Presidents Junior Award

10. Winding Up

10.1. In the event that South Cave and Brantingham Cricket Club decides to discontinue, the Club shall be disbanded and all records deposited with a suitable public body to be determined at the time.

10.2. In the event of winding up, any funds within the bank account will be returned to the donor, where possible. If this is not possible the club will donate any residual funds to a suitable local charity, following approval from the Committee.

11. Alterations to the Constitution

11.1. Alterations to the constitution of the club can be proposed, discussed and voted on at the AGM. Alterations outside of the AGM can only be made after a proposal has been circulated to all members of the club with notification of the date, time and place of the meeting at which the proposal will be discussed and voted on.
