Cost of Nets up from £526 to £720! Income down. £300 deficit but we must stand this charge for the sake of our younger players and the hip joints of the decrepit.

Patrons donations are from Stewart Franks, Vinod Iyer and Saftrans Ltd. Without these generous benefactors our financial situation would be much worse.

Income from Match Fees were very much below expectations from the 1st X1. This resulted from Philip Burgess taking on more duties than were reasonable. His dedication to lots of pavilion maintenance and groundwork and captaincy and administration meant that an Income from collected monies matched the Expenditure for materials for pavilion repairs. Thank you Philip - without your work there would not have been a game on.

Electricity-wise we are now with Southern Energy, via Swalec (South Wales Electricity). Swalec give ex-Yorkshire Electricity customers a good rate because Drax Power Station is in Yorkshire and burned Welsh coal. Swalec are part of Scottish and Southern Energy now - so we get the Southern bit!! Clear?. If it is then please do let me know.
